work with all stock classes, including deer, and contribute to day-today decisions as well as broader farm planning and decision-making.




Contour: Easy rolling country.

Subdivision/Fences: Mainly conventional 7 wire fences with 2 electric wires, there is some

internal sub-division with single wire electrics for pasture

management as required. 58ha of deer fencing.

Woolshed & Other Buildings: 4 stand woolshed, good set of sheep yards, drenching race has a

cover.

There is a second 3 stand woolshed with yards.

There is a set of Prattley yards for use on farm when requiring satellite

yards at different times of the year.

The properties are fully reticulated on the Farm Road scheme. Water:

Machinery: Quad bikes, 2 tractors for feeding out, topping, general maintenance.

Tracks: The farm is well laned and tracked for ease of stock movement.

Production System Intensive

Stock Policy - Breeds/Number: All seasonal farming activities is done from April to November and

then they unload stock for the summer.

Sheep

1000 MA ewes to terminal sire, all lambs finished. Winter trade lambs

as seasons permit.

Cattle

Cattle 850 Trade Friesian bulls. 400 young replacement stock.

Deer

300 velveting stags.

Terminal Policy: Kelso terminal ram.

Sheep – Mating/

Ram – 1st March Lambing/Weaning Dates:

Lamb – late July

Wean - milk draft mid-early Nov, then wean and then all gone in


January.

Cattle Policy: Buy a portion of autumn born calves at 100kg.

Buy spring born weaners in the following autumn at 200kg.

All other replacements are purchased at varying times of the year as feed allows ensuring numbers held in the second winter are sufficient

to finish the following spring and early summer.





Deer Policy: 300 Stags – velvet from end of September through to December.

Stags are brought in – have them for 10-12 years, some are culled,

dependent on their production.

Animal Health Practices: A strong animal health plan is in place, the farm works closely with

their local vet.

Cropping Policy: Winter fodder crop for stags and ewes.

Followed by chicory with grass renewal programme.

Contractors are engaged for cropping work.

For any major re-grassing programmes, the paddock will be sprayed

off and direct drilled.
